You can submit a poem, or a piece of artwork; there is no age restriction and there is no cost to enter. Entries will be judged according to age categories: Under 12s, Under 18s and Adults

## Deadline for entries: 29th February 2024

### RULES

*(summary only: please see [chilternarts.com](http://chilternarts.com) for full entry requirements)*

- \* Poems must be no longer than 200 words; there is no minimum length
- \* Digital submission is preferred (high resolution where relevant); high quality photographs are acceptable
- \* Postal entries must be no larger than A4, and must be 2D
- \* One entry per person
- \* All work must be the original work of the entrant
- \* All work must be unpublished
- \* Artists / writers will retain Copyright of their work, but by submitting an entry, the artist / writer gives Chiltern Arts permission to reproduce and use the work at its discretion
