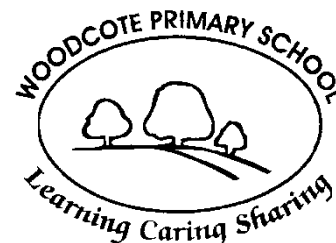


Sports Funding 2020 / 21

This year we received a total of £17,690 in our Department for Education Sports PE and Sport Funding allocation, which we have used to directly improve the quality of sport and PE for all children.



Due to the Lockdown period in the summer term we still carry forward £4952 from last year's funding, making a total this year of £22,642.

Overall Impact from Funding:

- Expenditure this year was halted by a further lockdown period.
- Under the circumstances pupils had a good number of sporting opportunities within school
- More equipment for the teaching of PE
- School's own swimming instructors and lifeguards to support swimming lessons
- The offer of swimming lessons for KS2 children from an early age
- 100% of year 6 children can swim confidently, competently and consistently over more than one stroke and can perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

More impact was planned but Covid restrictions made these impossible to achieve in the academic year.

Intentions for 2021/22

We intend to continue with the above, and increase back to our usual high standard, Covid restrictions allowing.

- Swimming from year 2 - 6
- Training for teachers where observation and moderation shows requirement
- Return to before and after school sports clubs
- Support for Pupil Premium Children in clubs
- Achieve the Gold Kite Mark, if and when the award is made available, once again.
- Become a hub school for partnership offers of competitive and collaborative sports
- New Trim Trail for whole school activity (£10,500 of which is represented by the underspend from 2019 and 2020 plus an additional contribution from the next academic year)
- Sports Coaches to enhance school offer to all
- Workshops in different dance genres from around the world.
