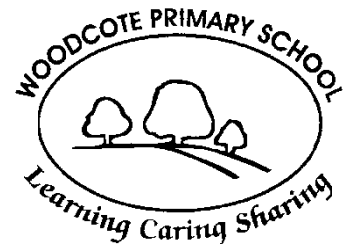


Sports Funding 2017 / 18

This year we received a total of £17,660 in our Department for Education Sports PE and Sport Funding allocation, which we have used to directly improve the quality of sport and PE for all children.
