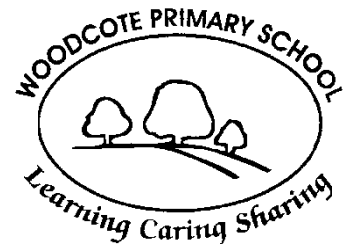


Sports Funding 2016 / 17

This year we received a total of £8,845 in our Department for Education Sports PE and Sport Funding allocation, which we have used to directly improve the quality of sport and PE for all children.



The school also carried forward £2200 from last year's funding, making a total this year of £11,045.
