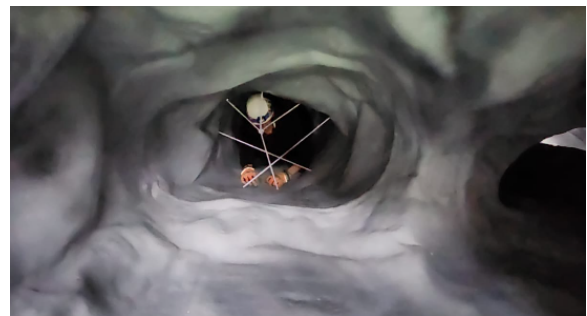
When they got to school at 7:20 they mad shore that they had ever. The children were mad to check that they had a lite. Then the coach arrived.
