

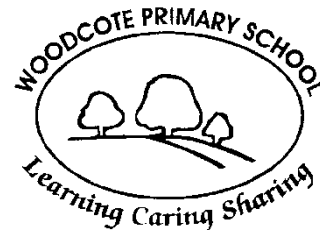

Job Description

Key Stage 2 Teacher

Main Responsibilities

In addition to the duties outlined in the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document you will be directly accountable to the Headteacher and responsible for fulfilling the role of Class Teacher by meeting the following duties:

Specific Duties

- Teaching of pupils in Year 5.

Teaching Duties

- Ensure a high level of education and welfare of your designated class of pupils with regard to the requirements of the National Curriculum and the school's aims, values and ethos.
- Promote good progress for all pupils by understanding the needs of different learners and planning and teaching well-structured and suitably differentiated lessons accordingly.
- Use PPA time effectively to ensure high standards in teaching and learning.
- Provide teaching of a consistently good standard, delivering lessons which show good subject and wider knowledge in a manner that meets the schools aims to provide an enriched, creative curriculum.
- Motivate and challenge all pupils by providing high expectations; foster independent learning and self-motivation.
- Develop and maintain effective communication with parents which builds a strong home/school partnership.
- Provide or contribute to oral and written assessments relating to individual pupils or

groups of pupils, internally, with parents and outside agencies.

- Use the assessment processes and procedures in use at the school to ensure a clear understanding of individual pupil attainment and progress throughout the academic year.
- Take part in school activities, training and meetings as and when appropriate.

Health & Safety

- Proactively ensure a suitable and safe learning environment is provided for all pupils.
- Instil good behaviour, trust and respect at all times.
- Undertake training when necessary and demonstrate clear understanding of school policies and procedures regarding Health & Safety and the safeguarding of all children.
- Liaise with partnership schools, other educational establishments, external support agencies or other professionals to ensure the safety and well-being of pupils.
- Contribute to and reinforce the personal, social, health and citizenship education of pupils according to school policy and ensure they are aware of health & safety issues as and when they arise.
- Inform the relevant person of any incidents or accidents immediately.

Other Duties

- Assess and pursue own professional development taking advantage of training opportunities as they arise.
- Follow and promote school policies and procedures.
- Take part in whole school activities when appropriate and engage with the wider school community.
